Minutes of last meeting/matters arising	<p>Matters arising:</p> <p>NCRI consumer forum involvement with charity project The former request on NCRI Consumer Forum involvement with the body of guidance charity project was unclear. The forum is formally represented on the project team through Lesley Turner and Ann Russell, who have kept the forum informed of collaboration activities at regular NCRI meetings. It was clarified that we want the NCRI Consumer Forum to become more actively involved at later stages of the project – for consumer input into the resource, evaluation etc, as they are well-placed to access patients.</p> <p>Action: Re-draft point for the minutes from August meeting for clarification and discuss again with LT to clarify how we hope the NCRI Consumer Forum might be involved in the future.</p> <p>Action: Upload minutes of last Secretariat onto website</p> <p>Statement of intent A statement of intent to explain the aims and objectives of the charity engagement is required for the website. This is outstanding from the previous Secretariat meeting.</p> <p>Action: Write statement of intent relating to charity engagement after the project meeting on 21st September.</p> <p>Action: Create charity section on website and upload content once agreed by the Secretariat.</p> <p>Knowledge Mobilisation Research Fellowships (KMRF) SAW has spoken to Ruth Boaden (Director of NIHR CLAHRC Greater Manchester and Chair of KMRF panel) regarding the KMRF opportunities. Applicants need to work with NIHR to develop and receive support on their applications, therefore it is not possible to apply for this round, which closes on 14th September 2017. 	<p>KMRF funding, in consultation with the Secretariat.</p> <p>Collaboration chair SAW has spoken to Professor Diana Eccles and Emeritus Professor Sam Ahmedzai regarding the position of Chair to the collaboration. No decisions have yet been made. The collaboration is seeking someone to chair the collaboration rather than chair and lead. We are looking for someone well-recognised within the clinical and academic cancer community, who can be supported by SAW as a Deputy Chair with nutrition expertise.</p> <p>Phase II report Two hundred hard copies of the Phase II report are being produced with funds released by SAW. The hard copies should be ready in time for the Steering Committee and research workshop being run on 13.09.17. Producing the report has been a helpful exercise in capturing the activities of the collaboration, in terms of what has been achieved so far and the direction we are heading in.</p> <p>Action: The report will be given to all Steering Committee members, BRC Directors and other relevant NIHR infrastructure contacts, as well as NCRI CSG chairs. It will be Sam Ahmedzai's first Steering Committee meeting, representing the research sub-group and NCRI.</p> <p>Action: MB to write notes to support the agenda for SAW as acting Chair.</p> <p>Action: The collaboration to ask SA to confirm with the NCRI that he is acting in the capacity of a representative of that organisation.</p> <p>Clare Shaw is now considered to be the formal representative of the BDA, following discussion she has had with them.</p> <p>Amendments to the agenda: List as much as possible under 'matters arising' so people are aware of what will be brought up but not discussed in depth.</p> <p>NOCRI have limited capacity at the moment due to staff shortages but will continue to support the collaboration as much as they can. SAW will speak about opportunities offered by NIHR.</p>		
<p>6. Charity meeting</p>	<p>The meeting will take place on Thursday 21st September. The Secretariat thanks NOCRI for providing the venue and refreshments/lunch.</p> <p>SAW will attend the meeting and present an update on collaboration activities and an overview of how the charities fit in with the patient-focused research agenda. It will be stressed that the collaboration is offering the charities an opportunity to support our activity and work together to produce a body of evidence-based guidance on nutrition for patients and their clinicians.</p> <p>The next charity meeting planning teleconference is on Monday 11th September.</p>		
<p>7. NCRI/James Lind Alliance</p>	<p>The JLA is a technical process to help priority setting in association with patients and clinicians and is considered to be a formal methodological approach. NCRI are supporting a JLA on 'Living With and Beyond Cancer' – it is not exclusive to nutrition, but nutrition is within remit.</p>
